

Four Seasons Apartment J6 User Guide (Rev 6.3.10)

Entering the Apartment

Using the larger of the two keys turn to the right until you meet resistance and then give an extra turn

Situated on the wall immediately to your left is the energy key holder, please insert your energy key and turn on the corridor light switch. On entering the lounge/dining room check that the calor gas hob is operational and if not you will find the calor gas cylinder under the sink. The calor gas on off mechanism is an up and over action on the top of the cylinder – the projecting prong facing upwards is off and down is on. Simply swing the lever through 180 degrees.

If you find that you require a new calor gas bottle please see the daytime security guard and handyman. Entering the shower room you will see an AEG box on the right hand wall; please rotate the knob clockwise to the right to the second of the three positions, this is more than adequate for the on-demand electric water heating system.

You will find the water main taps again under the sink area and normally they will be left on. The sink and bathroom tap levers swing to vary temperature and lift to vary flow. The hob has the usual electronic ignition system and you need to adjust the flame in the normal way.

IMPORTANT:

PLEASE NOTE THAT WHEN USING SAUCEPANS A LARGE RING AND SMALL SAUCEPAN = HOT HANDLES SO ADJUST ACCORDINGLY OR USE OVEN GLOVES WHEN HANDLING SAUCEPANS

Please note that due to the hard water in Turkey to avoid premature failure of the electric kettle please would you use bottled water for making hot drinks. The water however is perfectly safe to drink.

At this stage please take a couple of minutes to read the notices on the lounge wall near the master light switches and be aware of the contents – we thank you for your cooperation.

Oven

To remove the annoying red flashing digital clock light press the left hand button just below the clock display and you will see that the clock now reads 12.00 then press the + button and hold it down until the time is correct- then release it and a few seconds later the time will be set and the flashing will have stopped.

To prevent children from turning on the oven press the key symbol button for five seconds until the key symbol appears in the display. To unlock press the key for another 5 seconds.

Using the function selector knob:

- 1 Left Hand Knob Rotating Clockwise to the first symbol = Upper and Lower Heat for Baking, Roasting or grilling on one oven level only.
- 2 Rotating clockwise to second symbol = 3D hot air for baking pizza or cakes etc on two oven levels.
- 3 Rotating to 3rd Symbol = lower heat where a dark crusty food bottom surface is required.
- 4 Rotating to 4th symbol = Hot air circulation assisted grilling for large pieces of meat.
- 5 Rotating to 5th Symbol = Large area grill for lots of beefsteaks, sausages, fish or toasting bread. The last symbol clockwise is for rapid heating.

The temperature knob is situated on the right and please note that for grill settings:

- 1 One dot situated between 200 and 250 = Low grill.
- 2 Two adjacent horizontal dots = Medium Grill.
- 3 Three adjacent horizontal Dots = High Grill.

Please see pages 41-51 of the oven manual in the Four Seasons user guide folder for precise temperature settings and cooking times for all varieties of food.

For those users who want to explore advanced features please see oven manual but bear

in mind that power cuts are not uncommon here and so auto cooking features may sometimes fail.

Air Conditioning and Heating (Combined Units)

You will find 3 LG BEKO units situated in the lounge and both bedrooms, the remote controls for these units are situated in wall mounts (Lounge near notices board, master bedroom near left bedside light, and twin bedroom on wall above master light switch).

The A/C system is started by pressing the blue button on the remote control.

To choose between heating and cooling press the top left button and you will see either a Sun logo or a similar symbol that on close inspection looks like double crossroads, choose sun symbol obviously for heating and vice versa.

To adjust fan speed use the bottom left button and you will switch from four bars to seven bars to nine bars pressing the button a fourth time will give you a little squiggly arrow this will give you a continuously varying fan speed to simulate a natural breeze

A very useful button is the top right button showing a clock symbol which is used to program the auto switch off time in 1 hour increments. You can therefore turn on the unit before retiring to bed and it will switch off after say 1 hour depending on how many times you have pressed the button e.g. two presses = 2 hour turn off. etc but the set increments are visible in the remote display as 1h etc.

To adjust the flow direction of air press the middle right button and the louvres will swing continuously to simulate natural breeze. To adjust the louvre direction to your preferred and static position simply wait until the louvre is at the position you require and quickly press the button again.

To achieve rapid cooling e.g. when you have been out and the temperature has reached 30 or more degrees press the middle left button and the system will automatically choose 18 C as your desired temperature and will shut off after 30 minutes by which time you will be extremely cold. You can cancel this ofcourse after less than 30 minutes and we would appreciate it if this setting is not abused.

For normal air conditioning choose a desired temperature with the arrow keys and use the normal fan control speeds. Please note that in normal cooling mode once the temperature you set has been attained the fan will continue to keep air circulating although cooling will

have ceased. Again please turn the system off and ensure that good energy saving practices prevail to ensure we can maintain the competitive prices that we have instituted in J6 lettings. We thank you for your co-operation.

TV/DVD/SATELLITE

To turn on the system, locate the red switch situated on the 4 gang power block in the compartment just above the white drawer on the Hi-If Cabinet and turn it on (it will glow red) This will activate all three units in standby mode and we would appreciate it if you would ensure that the red switch is turned off when going out or retiring for the night.

To go from standby to TV operation locate the CREA TV REMOTE (normally on coffee table) and press the normal red standby button (top right) The red light on the Crea Plasma TV will flash and eventually turn green. Most of the TV settings do not need adjustment, the only control you really need to use is the AV button situated near the bottom of the remote on RHS. Press this to switch between Scart for satellite operation and AV for DVD operation. Please remember to press standby button on CREA REMOTE when not watching anything.

Satellite Tuner

Having ensured that the TV remote is set to SCART press left hand top button on silver remote you will see the display on satellite tuner indicate RUN.

To quickly get started press the FAV button and you will see the group menu on the left of the screen e.g. news , movies, music. Using the up and down arrow keys select the group you require and you will notice that as you do this the program channels visible on the right will alter.

You move to this right program section by using the right hand arrow key and you then move up and down this program list until you find what you want to watch and press the OK button You can adjust the volume using the V+ and V– keys. To scroll through all available services simply choose all services in the group menu.

For those of you who want extra facilities please see the Topfield 6000FE manual in the User Guide folder but please do not retune receiver and adjust favourites unless there is a real problem in obtaining programs.

We are aware that many of the programs are encrypted and that there are mainly news and a few music and other channels available (English) we have investigated how this can be improved and once rentals have commenced in earnest we will probably be addressing this with different equipment so please bear with us for now and enjoy the DVDs and CDs we have provided as well.

DVD Player

Ensure that the CREA TV REMOTE is set to AV mode by pressing the AV button until AV shows on screen.

Turn on DVD from standby by pressing the top left red button on GREY GOLDMASTER DVD REMOTE.

Press eject button (Top Right) Place CD or DVD on tray and once nicely located press eject button again to close the tray. Move between DVD menus by using the big arrow keys most functions are self explanatory.

Bathrooms

Please note that a supply of new towels is to be found on the towel rails and in the white bathroom cupboards along with extra toilet rolls.. The toilets have an automatic extractor

fan that operates in conjunction with the light switch so please ensure that when all odours have been removed the lights are turned off.

If you should experience any problem with residual bathroom odours locate the white plastic louvres on the bathroom floors swing the lever upwards and using this lever lift up and remove the louvre. Get a few glasses of water and ensure that the larger of the two compartments under the louvres contains water- just tip water until it is three quarters full - probably about 4 to 6 glasses at most and then replace the louvres back how you found them. If you don't want to do this just ask security and they will do it for you.

Dining Table

Please note that this is extendable to seat 6 people and the two extra chairs are situated in the two bedrooms.

Refrigerator

Turn the control knob until position 2 is adjacent to the grey arrow head. If weather is exceptionally hot e.g. June, July, Aug, and early September, you may need to select position 3 but see how you get on.

Washing Machine

The main controls are labelled in Turkish so please see translation sheet in user guide manual and sell taped close to machine. Basically the three buttons are Main Wash, Quick Wash and Start. Sikama meaning spin will flash when the wash is finished and you should then turn the knob to the top off position.

Sofa– Bed and or Chairs

To make settee in to sofa bed simply grip bottom of seat and lift upwards until head rest is horizontal then grabbing bottom of seat again push towards head rest until you hear a loud click the settee will then fold flat in to a large double bed.

This also applies to the chairs which will sleep small children. To convert the sofa bed back in to a settee grab the bottom of the bed and slowly hinge upwards until you hear a loud click then pause and continue to lift base slowly until you hear two clicks the two halves have then locked and you can swing the head rest in to the vertical position.

Cleaning and Laundry

For those renters who are staying longer than 10 days we have allowed for one interim clean of the apartment including one change of bed linen and towels. During this interim clean please ensure that the cleaner removes all used towels and used bedlinen. Please feel free to use washing machine for your personal washing requirements.

Window Shutters

The window shutters are activated by pull cord system you will see a cord and large plastic

spool near all the windows; from our experience it is best to use a hand over hand feeding method to raise and lower the shutters each day. It is not necessary to yank the cord forcefully.

Food & Drink Issues

Milk

We have found from experience that it is best to avoid the normal plastic milk containers and instead go for the cardboard cartons. The preferred brand is called Sutas and is widely available. The milk in the normal plastic containers is horrible.

Eggs

The eggs tend to have pure white shells but are absolutely delicious.

Tomatoes

These are extremely large but have a delicious flavour and can be purchased at rock bottom pricing at Manavgat market on Mondays (Shuttle takes you there - departs 10am)

Tap Water

This is safe to drink but you may prefer the flavour of bottled water obtainable very cheaply from supermarkets or from the pool bar or restaurant.

Electricity Adapters

You might like to pack a European 2 pin UK adapter which if you haven't already purchased is available either from your local Boots or from Boots at the airport. You may also like to obtain a UK shaving adapter from the same shop. There is a shaving power point in the bathroom near washbasin which has a white protective flap to avoid splashes, you simply lift up the flap to see the socket.

Nearest Supermarkets

It is planned for Mikhail who manages the Pool bar and internet cafe/restaurant to stock basic essentials so by the time you arrive this facility may be in place however there may be many other items you need to buy.

To reach your nearest small supermarket you will need to walk around 500 yards in total turning left at the Four Seasons entrance and following the road until you are about 20 yards before the end of the Football pitch fencing visible to your left. If you look over to your right at this stage you will see a turquoise public phone box. You need to turn right at this point (before the mosque) and you will see the supermarket on the right hand side of this side road after you have walked a further 100yards or so. It is not visible when you first turn right. There is another supermarket which you can reach by turning left after the end of the football fencing and following the road to the left of fire station for about 100 or so yards.

The nearest large supermarket is called Migros and the free Four Seasons shuttle will take you there and collect you every day except Sunday, if driving turn left at the Ilica archway and follow the D400 for about 2-3 miles and you will see it on your right.

We believe that the Carrefour supermarket in Manavgat is probably cheaper and alternatively you can ask the Four Seasons shuttle driver (Ferret) to drop you at the BIM supermarket en-route to Side

Nearest Pharmacy

This is found on the far side of the mosque where the road forks turning right past the mosque take the left of the two forking roads and it is only a few yards on the LHS

Nearest Internet Cafe

If you follow the road down the hill heading towards the main Antalya -Alanya Highway and the main Ilica Arch walking on the left hand side down the hill you will see the Internet cafe , it is about half a mile from Four Seasons .

Nearest Excellent Restaurant (Only our Opinion)

Heading in to Kumkoy either by shuttle or by Dolmus it is the writer's view that Kardelen (1st Restaurant on the right) takes some beating for value, quality and service. They do a particularly good Naan Bread, Tomato soup and grilled Chicken and will give you a lift back to Four Seasons.

Nearest Restaurant to Four Seasons

Basic Food only it is called Ikram and is situated about 1500 yards from Four Seasons reached by turning right at the Ilica Arches and walking to the Petrol Station - mainly useful for Sundays when shuttle bus does not operate. Please note there is a new restaurant now nearer to Four Seasons so please ask any owner for directions as we have not yet been there.

Public Buses (DOLMUS) and Four Seasons Shuttle

To catch a public bus to the large market town of Manavgat the nearest bus (Dolmus stop) is situated past the end of the football pitch fencing where you turn left and you will see a glass bus stop. The fare in to Manavgat (it takes about 25 minutes) is very cheap approximately £2.

To return from Manavgat is very easy simply make for the bus stop near NUR Pastalaneri coffee shop opposite side of road from HSBC and wait there until you see a Dolmus minibus saying ILICA-KUMKOY on the front. Most of these buses will take you past the Ilica archway to the top of the hill turning right near the mosque leaving you only 400 or so yards to walk back to Four Seasons.

On a Monday the four seasons shuttle bus will take you to Manavgat market at 10am free of charge and you can either wait for the driver to collect you or catch a Dolmus back as you prefer.

Every other morning the free shuttle bus will take you to the Migros supermarket (if you head left at the supermarket for about 100 yards you will see a Manavgat dolmus stop saving you even more when heading in to Manavgat. The shuttle driver (his name is Feret) will also take you to Kumkoy and or Side so for example if you wanted to go to Garanti bank or see the Excursion agent nearby just ask Feret to drop you at Garanti bank Side.

In the evening at 8pm Feret will take you either to a nearby restaurant in Kumkoy or to the town of Side. There are a number of restaurants which will return you to Four Seasons by

taxi eg Kardelen or Bistro 2000 in Kumkoy or Umutz in Side.

It is possible to catch a dolmus back to Ilica from Kumkoy or Side if for example you are out on the town but bear in mind that to return to Ilica from Side you will normally need to change buses in Kumkoy and you may need to wait for 20 minutes or so. Normally the Kumkoy buses back to Ilica have a final destination of Manavgat and so will normally drop you at the petrol station opposite the Ilica Arch so you will have to walk about 1000 yards or so up the hill back to Four Seasons. Alternatively you can hire a taxi from either Side or Kumkoy.

To catch a bus to Kumkoy the easiest way is to walk to the bottom of the hill, cross over the road to the petrol station go to the side road to the right of the petrol station cross over this side road and wait for next dolmus waving it down. If you don't want to wait it is possible to walk in to Kumkoy in about 20 minutes from that point or to walk the whole way from Four Seasons in about 40 minutes.

In the summer there is a new On-Demand Beach shuttle service run by a Beach café called Fizz Beach .See the notice board near Security office for contact telephone number and name or ask (security) to call the beach bus. We believe there are free sun beds on the beach.

Nearest Taxi

Ilica Taxis are situated only about 400 yards from Four Seasons turning left at Four Seasons archway you will see the taxi office just past the Football pitch on your right hand side just past the public phone box. Alternatively the Ilica taxi phone number is 009 (0) 242 7560667-8

Hammam (Turkish Bath)

One of the local Turkish Baths has instituted a collect and return you service (see for contact details and pricing or this may be in User Guide folder as well in apartment) This is an excellent way to relax and involves steaming, skin peeling and scrubbing with body massage and facial.

Day Trips

The enterprising restaurant manager at Four Seasons (Mikail) is now organizing a variety of daytrips so you do not even have to go out to choose an agent. However we would recommend that you look over a booklet (white spiral bound) which we have left in the

apartment and before booking compare his prices with those on offer at a small travel agent in Side. The phone number of the travel agent Mehmet is 0090 5325866224 and if you ask the shuttle driver to drop you at Garanti bank in Side the agent is on the left of the Bank just past the internet café.

IMPORTANT TIP

When arranging day trips please arrange to be picked up from a landmark like the Ilica Arches or one of the Kumkoy large hotels as many drivers just cannot find Four Seasons I learnt this the hard way.

A Fantastic Day Trip We have tried

(Only for the Adventurous)

If you are adventurous it is possible to take an exciting trip to the cable car (Longest in Europe only been working for 5 years and Swiss Built) the cable car takes you to the Summit of Mount Tahtali 2365 metres high and from where the views are absolutely amazing, it is like being on a plane and at the summit when I went (April) there was a significant amount of snow. So you get to see the amazing coastline its mountains and snow and clouds simultaneously.

To do this independently the cheapest option would be to drive to Kemer 40 km west of Antalya and approximately 14 km south of Kemer you turn right along a very windy road to the base station

If without a car (as I was) go to the Ilica archway half a mile from Four Seasons wait at the cafe just right of the archway for a bus and ask for Antalya Otogar (Bus Station) (8 Lira single) Then change buses at the Otogar and catch a Kemer Bus preferably an express one.

Head for the Ataturk Statue in the centre of Kemer and you will see the Agent called Mount Tahtali 2365 metres. You should pre-book a time and a (minibus red and white logo) will take you to the base station and return you to Kemer a couple of hours later, you pay the driver and this includes the cable car fee. It is 59 lira plus whatever it costs in buses to Kemer and back to Ilica (approx 25 lira.)

Health & Safety Issues

We would strongly recommend that you bring insect repellent with you as there is a fair chance of experiencing mosquito bites while in Turkey.

I am told that the most effective type is a spray called 'OFF' available from chemists and supermarkets in Turkey. You might also like to try the Lemon Eucalyptus sprays www.ebay.co.uk have them. If you prefer the Deet based types it is possible to get a spray with 100% deet called Repel 100 from www.amazon.co.uk I have only used partial Deet types which did not work for me but my sister reckons the 100% worked for her. It is very strong. The Repel from Boots is not the same and has bad reviews.

Sun protection cream is an absolutely essential item and our view is that a minimum Factor 30 and preferably Factor 50 type should be used as the Sun in southern Turkey is extremely fierce even in April & October. It is possible to purchase a good Factor 50 type with a trigger dispensing mechanism from Wilkinson for only around four pounds. We would also recommend that you purchase some Aloe Vera skin cooling & moisturising gel (again from Wilkinson).

The area around the circular splash pool is often used for sun bathing but please be aware that this area is sheltered from any breeze and should be used with caution as it is easy to get sunburnt.

Another essential item for both sexes is a good sun hat possibly of the wide brimmed type and children are especially vulnerable to the fierce sun and must be protected.

Important Visa Information

Please note that as Turkey is not yet an EU country you will need to purchase a 3 month Entry Visa for each person in your party at the special kiosk near Customs at Antalya airport. The price as of December 2009 was £10 sterling per person and you will need to have the necessary sterling with you to avoid problems & carrying several £10 notes will make the process totally stress free & fast.

An Excellent Turkish Night

You may be interested in some information about a local Turkish Night which we have just received from one of the owners on the Four Seasons Forum and which they say is excellent.

You catch the free Four Seasons shuttle bus to The China Court Restaurant just beyond Kumkoy, you then walk to the Post Office it is called PTT in Turkey, you then turn right down the hill to the beach, the restaurant is called ALMERO and it is the second along on the left (on the beach). You will need to go down and book ahead as it is very popular. I do not have the phone number at the moment.

More Restaurant Information

We do have some phone numbers and further details of restaurants which you may like to have with you in Turkey. Umut Restaurant will also deliver hot food to you at Four Seasons but make sure that you await food at security as they may not find the correct apartment.

Please note that the restaurants near Side Harbour tend to be expensive but those located just as you enter the town some ½ mile or so before you reach the harbour are much cheaper and often give very good value and nicely prepared food.

Car Hire

Please note that our current recommendation is a company called Antalya Rent a Car (Turtas Cars) it is extremely competitive and can offer a Renault Clio for around 18 euros per day. They will provide a car at the airport or you can collect one in Side. The website is

www.antalyarentacar.com and a friend of mine has used them and highly recommends them. You could also consider a company called Smile, website www.smilerentacar.com telephone 0090 242 753 27 15 or 0090 242 753 48 85 I believe they will deliver a car to the airport but the first company is probably a better bet.

There are many other car hire companies operating at the airport including Avis, Hertz, Europcar and Budget, for details of these see the Antalya Airport website <http://www.aytport.com/en/page.aspx?k=122> just click on Airport Services on Left hand Side and you will see car rental on the sub menu

Vacating the Apartment

Before leaving the apartment at the end of your holidays we would please request that unless advised to the contrary you carry out the following small tasks.

1. Please enter the shower room and on the AEG water heater box please rotate the knob anti clockwise until the heater is turned off.
2. Please return the air conditioning remote control units to their wall mountings.
3. Please open the fridge door and turn the knob inside to the off position.
4. Please ensure that the DVD TV and Satellite tuner are turned off by the master switch located on the power block in the Hi Fi cabinet. (Continued next page)
5. Please remove all of the white balcony furniture (6 White Stacking Chairs & Table) and bring it inside the apartment.
6. Please ensure that all the shutter blinds are down.
7. Please return all items you have removed eg Table Tennis Bats, Clothes Horse etc etc to their correct locations as in the section of the user guide (Where are things Located?)
8. Please remove all rubbish and place in blue skip near Four Seasons Arch.
9. Please ensure that washing machine is turned off.
10. Please hand back apartment keys and energy card to security before you leave Four

Seasons.
